## Sticky Keys? Easy to Fix!

Like anything else in your home, your CapTel phone can collect dust or dirt over time, which may cause the number keypad to stick occasionally. The fix is easy: simply clean your CapTel phone. Common household cleaners such as ordinary dish soap, Isopropyl Alcohol-based cleaners, or disinfecting wipes are all safe to use. Make sure the cloth or wipe is damp, not dripping. TIP: A soft-bristled toothbrush can reach into the spaces around the keys, to eliminate stickiness.
