CapTel 2400i Users: Testing Your Tone Control


As you adjust the Tone Control on your CapTel 2400i phone, you can test in advance how each setting will sound to help you find the optimal level for your own personal hearing.


Look for the instructions at the bottom of the screen as you experiment with the various Tone settings. Simply press PLAY to hear an example of how a man and a woman's voice will sound with each Tone selection. When you find the setting you like best, touch ACCEPT.

Finding Tone Control During a Call

New process! If you'd like to adjust the Tone Control during a call, the process has recently changed. Now, during your conversation, first touch the OPTIONS icon, then select your preferred Tone setting in the pop-up window.

After you make your selection, the pop-up window closes for you to continue your conversation. Whatever setting you selected will remain in effect until you change it again.


Popular Series Features Contestants with

FEDERAL LAW PROHIBITS ANYONE BUT REGISTERED USERS WITH HEARING LOSS FROM USING INTERNET PROTOCOL (IP) CAPTIONED TELEPHONES WITH THE CAPTIONS TURNED ON. IP Captioned Telephone Service may use a live operator. The operator generates captions of what the other party to the call says. These captions are then sent to your phone. There is a cost for each minute of captions generated, paid from a federally administered fund. No cost is passed on to the CapTel user for using the service.
